Single Incident

- Show personal significance.
- Summarize the event.
- Show feelings then.

Describe the Setting

- Describe only the place where the incident took place.
- Use descriptive language (sensory detail, figurative language, and colorful adjectives, adverbs, verbs, nouns, etc.)

Beginning of the Story

- Use descriptive language (sensory detail, figurative language, and colorful adjectives, adverbs, verbs, nouns, etc.)
- Use dialogue to tell your story.
- Share your thoughts and feeling about the incident when it happened.

Middle of the Story

- Use descriptive language (sensory detail, figurative language, and colorful adjectives, adverbs, verbs, nouns, etc.)
- Use dialogue to tell your story.



Ending of the Story

- Conclude your story.
- Tell how you feel about the incident now.
