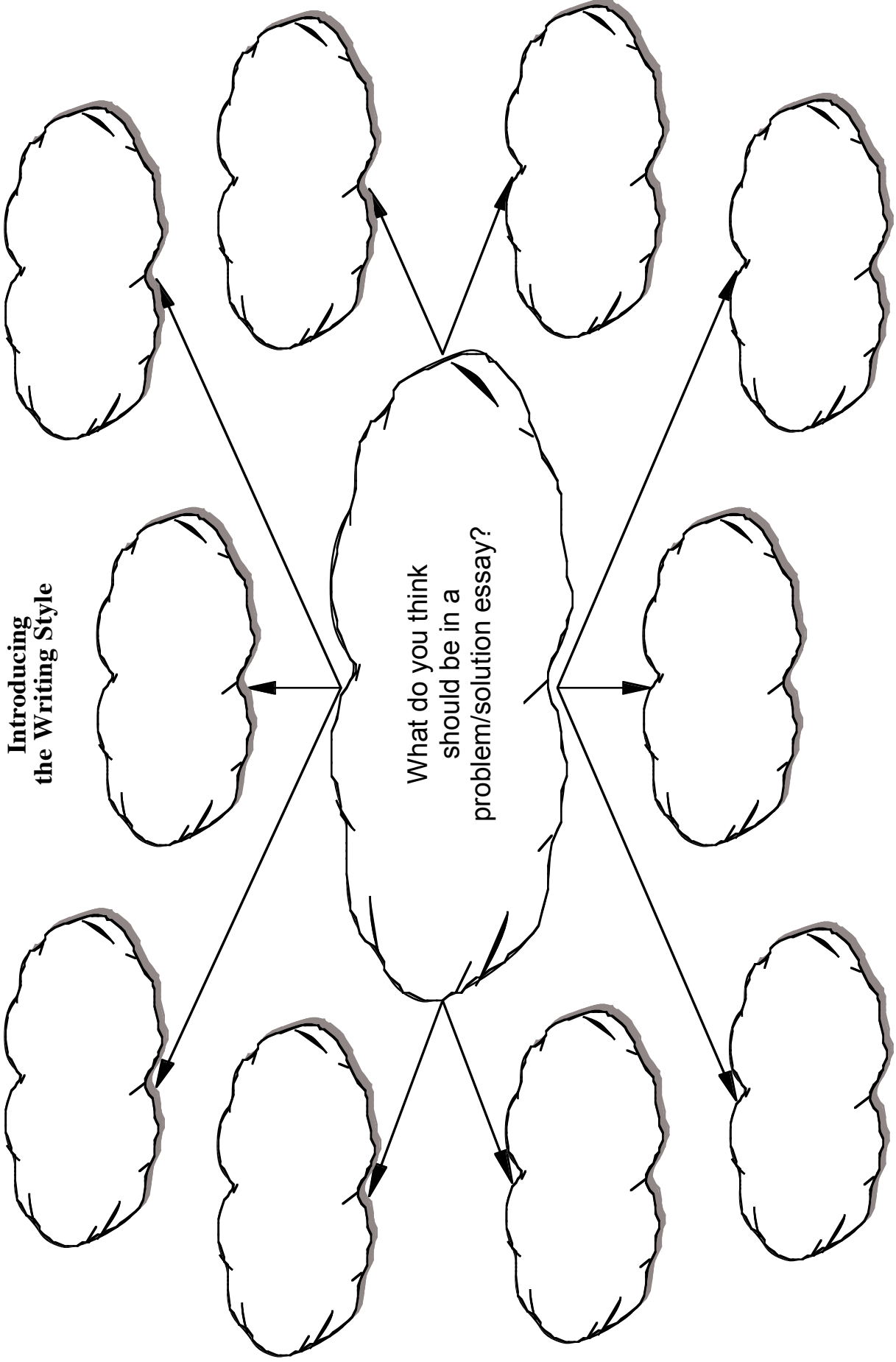

the Writing Style**



The writer uses an appropriate level of conventions (i.e., sentence structure, grammar and mechanics).

The writer suggests one or more realistic and convincing solution(s) to the problem.

The introduction includes a thesis that clearly identifies the problem and engages the reader.

The composition is about a single incident that is of personal significance to the author.

The writer proposes logical steps to carry out the solution(s).

The writer informs how he or she feels now.

The writer includes pictures.

The writer clearly explains the causes and effects of the problem.

The writer addresses the consequences of failing to solve the problem.

The writer uses figurative language.

The summary is short and concise.

The writer explores the pros and cons of the solution(s).

The conclusion restates the problem and its consequences and provides a rational for why one solution is best..

The writer organizes the essay in a logical, coherent and sequential manner.

The protagonist is well-developed.

The writer uses evidence and/or reasons to support the solution(s).
