	The Criteria	What I think it means
Content & Organization	The introduction identifies the author, title, and main idea of the text.	
	The summary includes details that support the main idea.	
	The writer paraphrases (i.e., uses his or her own words).	
	The writer uses active voice.	
	The writer uses third person.	
	The writer conveys the author's message in a neutral voice.	
	The conclusion restates the author's main idea.	
	The summary is short and concise.	
	The details are presented in a logical order.	
	The writer uses an appropriate level of conventions such as sentence structure, grammar and mechanics.
