

STEPS for writing a graph description



I <u>Step #1</u>

Read the title and labels on the graph as well as the instructions.

- \rightarrow Note down 2-3 synonyms for key words/phrases.
- \rightarrow Write your introductory sentence, trying not to copy any phrases.

Step #2

Analyze the information in the graph, looking at the overall trend(s).
 → Write the rest of your introduction, explaining the main trend(s).

Step #3

Plan your body paragraphs (probably one paragraph for each main trend).
→ Draft a topic sentence for each body paragraph.

Step #4

Choose the most important details that will support your statement(s) of main trend(s).

- \rightarrow Write the rest of the body paragraphs.
- \rightarrow Remember to include key figures from the data.



🖾 <u>Step #5</u>

Think about how to restate the main trend(s) in the graph using different words. \rightarrow Write your conclusion, paraphrasing the main trend(s).



Proofread your description. Check:



- → <u>Grammar</u>: Accuracy of noun phrases and verb phrases, correct verb tenses & prepositions.
- \rightarrow <u>Organization/coherence</u>: Linking words and variety of phrases/conjunctions.
- → <u>Content</u>: Is the information accurate and detailed enough? Do the details support the topic sentences?
