Alike	Similar	

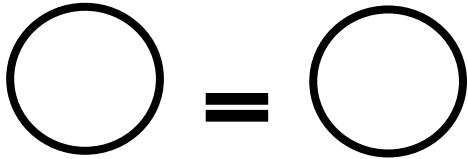
